An arbitration proceeding has been filed against the Company entitled, ChiRhoClin, Inc. vs. Repligen Corporation (Arbitration No. 131810059003) on March 4, 2003 with the American Arbitration Association in New York on March 4, 2003. ChiRhoClin, Inc. alleges a breach of contract for non-payment of royalties due under our licensing agreement based on a dispute regarding certain marketing expense reimbursements taken by the Company. ChiRhoClin, Inc.'s claim is approximately \$800,000. We believe these claims have no merit and will vigorously contest these claims. This arbitration is at an early stage and has been stayed pending the outcome of settlement discussions between the parties.
