Item 4. Changes in Registrant's Certifying Accountants

On May 6, 2004, Fulton Financial Corporation ("Fulton") signed an engagement letter dated April 30, 2004, with Crowe Chizek and Company LLC ("Crowe Chizek") to act as independent auditor of the following Fulton Financial Corporation benefit plans: Fulton Financial Affiliates 401(k) Savings Plan, Fulton Financial Corporation Profit Sharing Plan, Premier Bank 401(k) Savings Plan, Dearden, Maguire, Weaver & Barrett 401(k) Plan, Fulton Financial Affiliates Defined Benefit Pension Plan, and Drivers Defined Benefit Plan (together, the "Benefit Plans"). Crowe Chizek succeeds Smith Elliott Kearns & Company, LLC, which resigned as independent auditor of the Benefits Plans by letter dated February 4, 2004 (as reported on the Current Report on Form 8-K filed with the Commission on February 6, 2004).
