ASUR Reopens Airports

Mexico DF, August 21, 2007, Grupo Aeroportuario del Sureste, S.A.B. de C.V. (NYSE: ASR; BMV: ASUR) (ASUR), the first privatized Mexican airport group and the operator of Cancun International Airport and eight other airports in southeastern Mexico, announced that, as Hurricane Dean is leaving the Yucatán Peninsula, the Cozumel, Cancún and Mérida airports have resumed operations.
