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**Item 2.02. Results of Operations and Financial Condition.**

On April 28, 2005, Ingram Micro Inc. (["Ingram Micro"]) issued a press release announcing Ingram Micro's financial results for the period ended April 2, 2005 and an outlook for the second quarter ending July 2, 2005. A copy of the press release, together with the related financial schedules, are attached hereto as Exhibit 99.1, the text of which are incorporated under Item 12 of this Form 8-K by reference herein. This press release, together with the related financial schedules, are not to be deemed ["filed"] for purposes of Section 18 of the Exchange Act of 1934, as amended (the ["Exchange Act"]), or incorporated by reference in any filing under the Securities Act of 1933, as amended, or the Exchange Act, except as shall be expressly set forth by specific reference in such a filing, or to form a part of Ingram Micro's public disclosure in the United States or otherwise.

Financial results excluding major-program costs associated with Ingram Micro's profit-enhancement program, as well as those including off-balance sheet debt, are considered non-GAAP and are presented as supplemental information, along with other financial metrics such as accounts receivable, and total borrowings including off-balance sheet debt, to enhance the public's understanding of, and highlight trends in, the company's financial results excluding reorganization costs and major-program costs. Ingram Micro's management utilizes these non-GAAP financial measures, along with primary GAAP measures, in analyzing and measuring the performance of the company's core operations from period to period.
