 - (1) On October 14, 2008 and October 15, 2008, in accordance with a 10b5-1 Trading Plan, Morgan Stanley & Co., Incorporated, a registered broker-dealer, sold on behalf of Mr. Robert O. Carr, 50,300 and 29,700 shares, respectively, of the Common Stock of Heartland Payment Systems, Inc. (the "Company").
